- 1. Pupils are equal and reactive to light
- 2. Fifteen year old female JV soccer player
- 3. Patient reported taking two ibuprofen twice a day
- 4. Has a history of three previously diagnosed concussions
- Chief complaints are headache, dizziness, difficulty concentrating and "not feeling right"
- 6. Perform a SCAT6 examination
- Hit head on ground during a soccer game two days ago; did not report hit to coach, parents or athletic trainer and continued to play in the game
- 8. Balance Error Scoring System: 12/30 errors
- 9. Cervical range of motion uncomfortable in flexion and extension
- Stated she is struggling to concentrate, especially in math and science class, and finds it difficult to remain asleep at night
- 11. Concussion
- 12. Coordinate return to learn strategies with school nurse
- 13. Neurologic examination revealed a mild nystagmus in both eyes when looking to the left and right
- 14. Patient should take Tylenol as needed for headache and discontinue taking the ibuprofen


